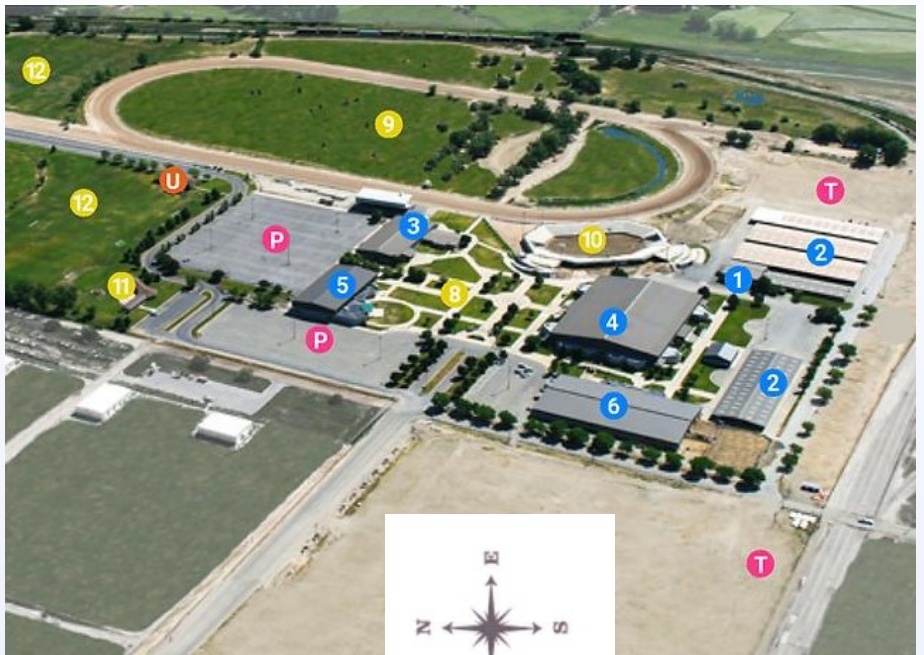

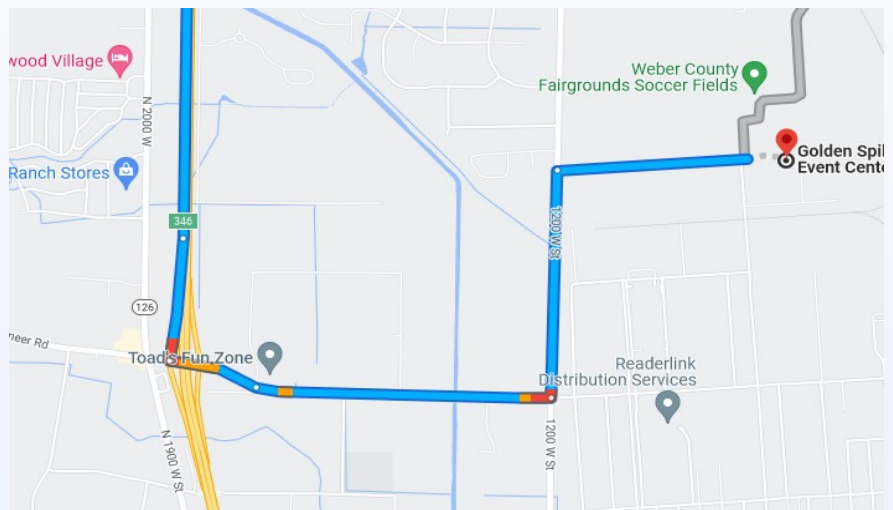

Saturday, January 7:

- All Entries need to be received by January 7 at Midnight if you want to show your birds at the Rocky Mountain Fanciers Summit.

Thursday, January 19:

- Show Setup will start at 8:00 am at the Golden Spike Exhibit Hall. All Specialty clubs must have at least **one representative that will work the entire duration of setup**. The Show Hall will be closed at 6:00 pm or once setup has been completed. Specialty clubs may setup their judging areas and exhibitors can start cooping there birds once setup has been completed.
- Exhibitor Dinner will be served from 4pm to 6pm, Free to all those that entered birds in the show.

Friday, January 20:

- Show Hall Opens at 8:00 am
- All Birds must be cooped by 10:00 am and Judging will begin shortly after
- Show Hall will Close at 6:00 pm

Saturday, January 21:

- Show Hall Opens at 8:00 am
- Junior Judging and Showmanship will start at 10 am
- All Breed Judging must be completed by 1:00 pm
- Live Auction will start at 1:30 pm
- Best in Show Judging will begin at 2:30 pm
- Awards will be presented after the Best in Show Judging is completed
- Birds may be boxed following the awards presentation. Once no birds are missing from the show your entries will be released.
- Show cleanup will follow the release of entries. All specialty clubs must have at least on representative that will work the entire duration of the cleanup.

Show Rules

If you cannot abide by these rules, please do not enter as exceptions are seldom made and we want a peaceful and fun event for all!

1. The Utah Pigeon Club recognizes all reputable banding organization's seamless bands of the appropriate size.
2. The Utah Pigeon Club and sponsoring specialty clubs have selected responsible judges and as such their decisions are final.
3. The best security possible is provided to all entries; the Utah Pigeon Club and its officers are not responsible for the loss of any entries.
4. All entries must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor.
5. The show management team reserves the right to deny entries for not meeting the rules and to disqualify and/or remove any entries that appear to be unhealthy and a danger to other entries.
6. No pigeons will be allowed in the show hall for which an entry fee has not been paid, except for the birds selected for the Utah Pigeon Club auction.
7. No Birds will be allowed into the show hall that are from a County that is under quarantine with New Castle Disease or any other disease
8. No pigeons will be allowed to leave the show hall prior to the general release without specific written permission from the show management team.
9. Substitutions are only allowed when made within the same breed and must follow any rules of the sponsoring specialty club.
10. Judging may occur at any time during the show hours at the discretion of the sponsoring specialty club or the show management team.
11. The show management team has final say in all disputes and has the right to make exceptions to these rules on a case-by-case basis.
12. All birds must be cooped no later than 10:00 am on Friday, January 20. All birds will be released at 5:00 pm on Saturday, January 21 or when the Show Director releases the show.
13. No Judging areas will be set up until the show is 100% set up.
14. All Club Rebates and Entries must be signed before cooping birds.
15. Final Judging 2:30 pm owners bring their own birds to the showing station.

2023 Junior Show Rules

- Only Exhibitors that are under 18 years of age are allowed to compete for the awards.
- All juniors can enter 2 birds in the junior competition
- The 2 birds the junior is entering need to be marked on the judging sheet in case the junior is not able to attend.
- Only Birds raised by the junior are allowed to compete in the junior show. No purchased, or gifted birds may compete in the junior show.
- Juniors are allowed to enter as many birds as they want in the show but only 2 birds will be allowed in the junior competition.

2023 Junior Showmanship

The Junior Showmanship is designed to get our youth excited about pigeons. You do not need to preregister but you do have to have at least one bird entered in the show. While we do not have a dress code for our participants, your appearance should be tidy.

You will need to have a pigeon present at the competition.

In the Showmanship class a judge may ask questions. Here are some examples of Questions and/or topics (Note: Appropriate questions will be selected for each participant based on age. Additional questions not listed here may also be asked).

Basic Questions:

- Name the breed of your bird?
- Point out basic body parts on the bird (head, feet, tail, etc.)?

Moderate-Advanced Questions:

- What characteristics does your breed have?
- Point out body parts on the bird (crest, frill, globe, etc.)?

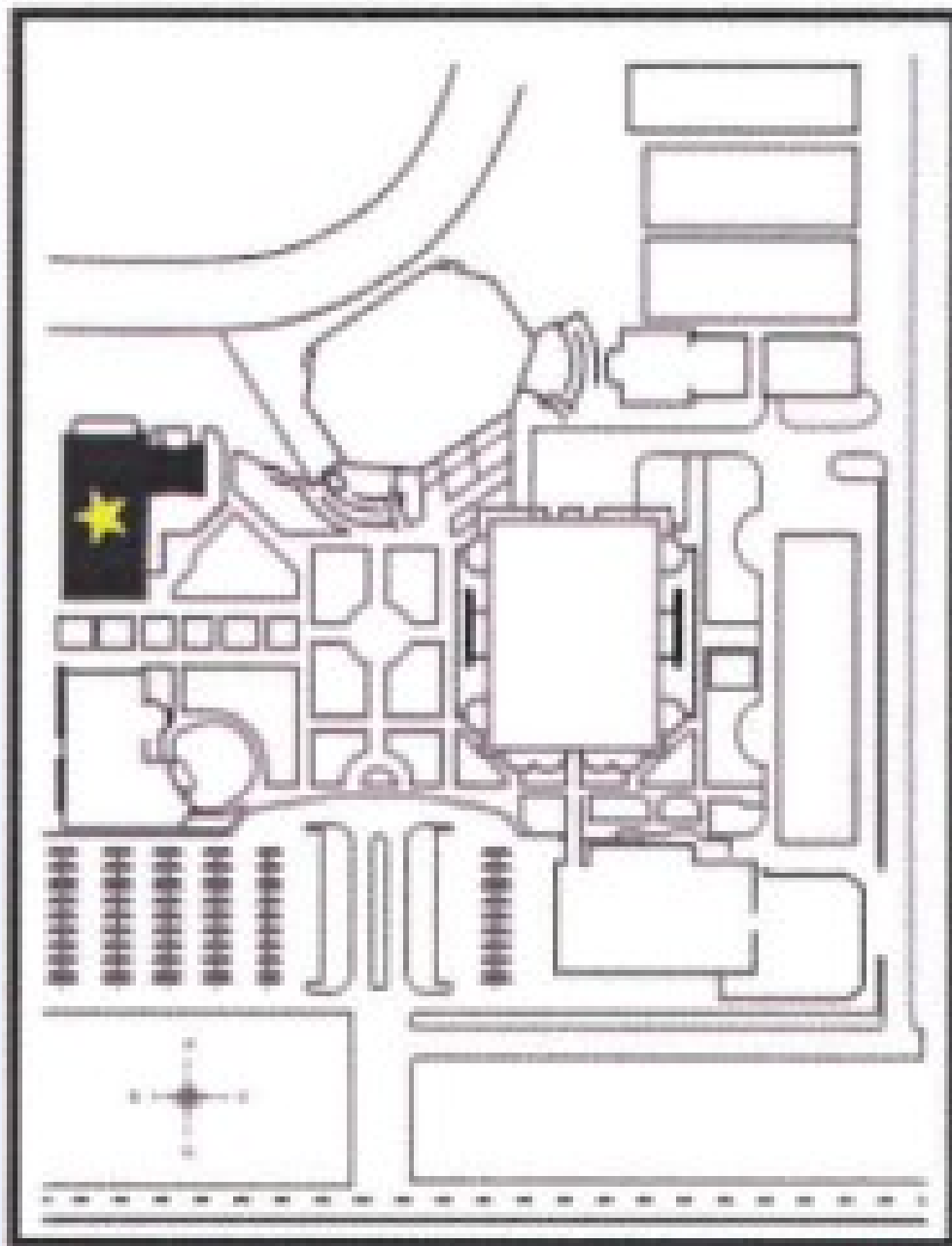
